Subject: Intimation under Regulation 30(6) of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements), Regulations, 2015.

Dear Sir/ Madam,

There have been various complaints relating to the pollution of river Ghot in recent past with Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB) and other authorities. There has been a media article on the subject matter in regional newspaper 'Karnala' dated 16<sup>th</sup> September 2018. The article mentions that the river Ghot has been polluted due to water seepage from a dumping ground. Our Taloja unit is in nearby vicinity.

Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulation, 2015, this is to inform that the Company has received a notice from MPCB directing closure of our unit located in Taloja by evening of Tuesday, Sep 18, 2018. In recent past, a minor leakage from a domestic sewage chamber was observed which was rectified and closed to the satisfaction of MPCB officials vide their visit report dated Sep 12, 2018. There were no other adverse observations in this visit report.

We understand that some of the other units located in the area have also been served similar notices.

We would like to state that our facility at Taloja area has a **ZERO LIQUID DISCHARGE (ZLD) WASTE WATER TREATMENT FACILITY.**

- We have an efficient water management process based on reduce, recycle and reuse concept.





- Any liquid effluent including domestic sewage generated are segregated and treated with best available technology at the site itself.
- The water treated at the facility is recycled within our plant premises.
- ZLD processes have been approved by MPCB and are regularly monitored by them.
- The operations at our plants are handled by trained and experienced professionals.

We are representing to MPCB for withdrawal of the closure notice and submitting all relevant documents for the same.

We are committed to comply with all the applicable regulations and to operate all our facilities in a sustainable way.
